

In this latter part of the Easter season, for the 5th and 6th Sundays of Easter, the Gospel is from John 14, from the *Last Discourse* of Jesus at the Last Supper. Jesus asks us to displace the fear in our lives with faith in him. This passage today from John 14:1-12 is one of the choices for the Gospel at a funeral Mass, and is commonly chosen by many people. Jesus tells us that there are many dwelling places in his Father’s house. He then proceeds to tell us that he is going to prepare a place for us and that “I will come back again and take you to myself, so that where I am you also may be.” The options which the Church provides for readings for the Funeral Mass, express two themes: (1) Our hope of sharing union with God forever in heaven and with our loved ones and (2) the saving action of Jesus’ death and resurrection.

I was reading recently of how people’s understandings of heaven are expressed these days. People talk about being reunited with their loved ones in heaven. I can certainly understand this. The human bonds that we form in this life are so strong. Yet, I do not hear as often people express their desire to be with God in heaven after their death. Our faith leads us to see that these two desires (the reunion of loved ones in heaven and beholding the *Beatific Vision* of God in heaven) are not mutually exclusive. As in good Catholic understanding, the theological principal is “*Both this and that*” not “*Either this or that.*” So much is lost if we only think of the after-life as being with our loved ones. God our Father, created us so that we may have life with him in heaven for all of eternity. It is not a passive existence, but a new active existence, which is beyond any joy that we can imagine in this life.

Jesus came to reveal God the Father to us and to reveal the Father’s love for us. How well do you know God the Father? I would suggest that in the remainder of this Easter season, you ask God the Father to help you to know him better and to grow in your relationship with him, as a son or daughter. In Baptism, we were adopted by God as his very own sons and daughters. Get to know this Father who reveals himself by showing us his Son Jesus. Philip the Apostle asked Jesus, “*Master, show us the Father, and that will be enough for us.*” Jesus replies that “*Whosoever has seen me has seen the Father.*” Jesus has revealed the Father’s love to us. Jesus also tells us that “*no one comes to the Father, except through me.*” Last Sunday, we heard of Jesus who is the gate (sheep-gate). Through the gate, we enter into life. Grow in your relationship with Jesus and you come to know God the Father.

On behalf of the priests, I wish all Mothers a blessed Mother’s Day. Thank you for carrying out your vocation as mother. We remember in prayer all mothers, living and deceased.

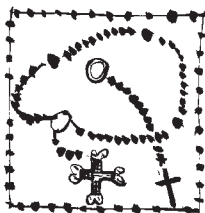

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our diocesan priests dedicate their lives to serve and guide us on our life-long journey of faith. They have administered the sacraments, counseled, encouraged and prayed for us and our families. And just like many of us, they desire a suitable place to live once they reach retirement.

Currently there are 182 diocesan priests faithfully serving Jesus Christ and you, the people who form our diocesan Church. Of these, 21 priests are retired; and over the next ten years 20 additional priests will reach retirement age.

Next weekend, May 20 and 21, at all Masses, the annual second collection for retired priests will take place in all parishes in our diocese.

The funds from this annual collection will assist several special needs including the ongoing operational expenses of the *Saint Rose of Lima Priests Retirement Villa*, a beautiful and restful home that includes common areas and private suites for up to 15 priests. Since his retirement, Bishop Emeritus Paul Loverde has called this retirement villa his home. This special collection also will provide funds for post-retirement health care, nursing home care, and the priests' pension fund.

I ask you to be as generous as possible, so that our priests, who served us so faithfully, may be fittingly cared for in their retirement years.
