All Saints is a tithing parish, giving of our time, talent, and treasure so as to give glory to God.

JESUS IS OUR EUCHARIST. JESUS IS OUR LIFE.

On this Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, we can renew an awareness of the great gift of Jesus in the Eucharist. Formerly this feast was known as *Corpus Christi*. After the 2nd Vatican Council it was combined with the feast of the *Precious Blood* into the feast as we call it today: *The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ*. It still remains popularly called *Corpus Christi*.

We profess our faith in the Eucharist as the Body and Blood of Christ. The Eucharist is not a symbol, although it does have symbolic characteristics in the bread and wine that are consecrated. The Eucharist is the presence of Christ in a way like no other mode of presence that exists. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, Christ changes (“*transubstantiates*”) bread and wine into his own body and blood. Jesus is present in the Eucharist as he now is in his glorified body in heaven. Belief in the Eucharist is a core belief of our Catholic Faith. What has the appearance (“*accidents*”) of bread and wine, now is, in substance, the actual Body and Blood of Christ, the Risen Lord.

As Catholics, we are called to deepen our belief in the Eucharist. Reflect on what this means for us. The effect of the Eucharist is that we are brought into communion with God and with each other.

Also, on this feast, I want to thank our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion who not only assist in the distribution of Holy Communion at Masses, but also assist with home visitations to the sick and shut-ins, Novant Health Prince William Medical Center, and in our jail ministry.

Several years ago, I was on trip to Ohio for a funeral of the father of a religious sister whom I knew. I was in Elyria, Ohio (near Cleveland). I arrived early, so I spent some time in their daily Mass chapel. 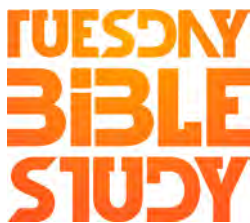
