

Do you know what a #10 can is? My father was a food broker who worked with growers and manufacturers and arranged for canned goods and other foods, to be purchased and shipped from wholesalers to retail grocery stores and specialty shops. I learned early in life what a #10 can was because he would get samples of canned food in this institutional-size can. Think of a large can of coffee.



In the summertime, before the children in my family could go outside to play, we would sometimes have chores that we had to do. One of these was to dig up weeds such as dandelions from the yard or weeds in the wonderful vegetable garden that my mother grew. When we had filled up a #10 can with weeds, we could go out to play. At my young age, I thought that it took a long time to fill the can! The parable of the weeds among the wheat [Matthew 13] had me thinking this week of this childhood activity.

The parable of the weeds among the wheat may seem counter-intuitive when we first hear this parable. Our initial reaction to seeing sin in our midst can be to want to get rid of the sin (and the sinner) as soon as possible. That is the response of pulling up the weeds as quickly as possible. However, we learn something of divine understanding and patience from this parable. God, who is all-powerful, is willing to wait for the sinner to turn back to him. He allows us to use our human freedom, even if we use it incorrectly and choose to sin, in the hope that eventually we will repent and change. Through this parable Jesus is teaching us about God the Father's understanding of existence, which is what we call the kingdom of heaven (or the kingdom of God).

This week, pray for the grace to be patient with others, especially those whose actions may be sinful. Perhaps our good example will be what causes them to stop and think about their own choices in life.

Even within ourselves, we find a mixture of "wheat and weeds" — goodness and sin. Be patient with yourself. Use the sacrament of Penance not only to have your sins forgiven, but to receive and use the grace given in the sacrament so as to grow in virtue. Virtue grows by repeated acts of goodness.

May this week be filled with the growth of virtue which can overcome the sin which drags us down.

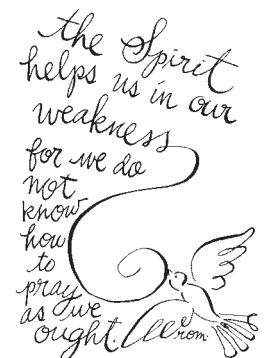



