### MISSION APPEAL:

#### SOCIETY FOR THE PROPAGATION OF THE FAITH


Next Sunday's **2nd Collection** is the annual Mission Appeal for the Society of the Propagation of the Faith. Here is some information on this year's mission.

Fr. Suresh Thirumalareddy of the Diocese of Jackson, Mississippi, will be with us next Sunday to appeal for help for the Diocese of Jackson, the largest diocese east of the Mississippi River. The Catholic population is around 50,000. The Diocese of Jackson has nine counties without a resident priest. An appeal came recently to hire a sister for one of these priestless counties. We had to say, "We're sorry. There's not enough money." And so, that leaves another county without Catholic presence of any kind. Won't you help us to make the church present in our diocese, which is less than 3% Catholic? Would you like to help a school? Sr. Thea Bowman School in West Jackson, founded in 1945, serves an African American community. They provide quality education in a Catholic environment. There are presently 50 students in Grades Pre-K to 6. The great tradition of Sister Thea Bowman is continued in the Sister Thea Bowman Memorial Choir. The school emphasizes computer-based instruction in every classroom, and offers an Advanced Learning System. Tuition from student families only provides one-third of the financial resources needed to run the school. The remaining funds come from the Mission Fund of the Diocese as well as independent fund-raising efforts. The annual tuition is \$3,950.00. Please help sponsor a child at Sr. Thea Bowman School.

Saint Anne Parish is located in the city of Carthage, in rural central Mississippi. They are the only Catholic parish in Leake County taking in 584 square miles with a county population of 26,000. It is a multicultural parish community where representatives of six different cultural groups are actively participating in the life of the parish. Among the approximately 600 parishioners, we have six languages spoken: English, Spanish, Choctaw, Visayan, Vietnamese and Mam — the language of the Mamas Indians from Guatemala, who are a growing population here. About 90% of their parishioners live at or below the poverty line. The parish is not self-supporting now and with the daily increase in folks earning the minimum wage, their financial status will remain the same. They depend on the assistance of out-of-state donors for nearly one-half of their annual income.

Mission Appeals make it possible for over 1,000 poor and underprivileged children to attend Pre-School and Elementary School in the Diocese of Jackson. Because of these programs we are also able to feed several hundred children and young people in the summertime at our Mission Schools. Because of the generosity of the people who participate in our appeals, people who have the fewest opportunities are given choices they would never experience.

	Edith Stein was born in Breslau, Germany (now Wroclaw, Poland) in 1891 of Jewish parents. She studied philosophy under Husserl, the leading phenomenologist of his day. Inspired by the writings of St. Teresa of Avila, she was baptized 1 January 1922. She taught in various schools from 1923–1933 until forced to resign due to anti-Semitic legislation. ↓

At the end of 1939, she moved to the convent at Echt, Holland, on account of the Nazi persecution of Jews, but in 1942, during the German occupation of Holland, she was arrested, transported to Poland, and killed (9 August) at the concentration camp at Auschwitz.	Lawrence, died 258, four days after four other deacons and Pope Sixtus II were killed; cared for the temporal welfare of the Roman church; said to have been burned alive on a gridiron; after Peter and Paul, Lawrence is venerated as patron of Rome. 


