Foundation and Ethics

• Pledge of Allegiance, Scout Oath, Scout Law and Outdoor Code, Be Prepared and Do a Good Turn Daily and basic skills.

Life Skills

- More than just camping and hiking.
- Via rank advancement and merit badges such as Personal Management, Communications, Cooking and First Aid.
- By the time you reach the highest rank you will have completed thirteen interviews.

Achievements

• Rank advancement and service projects.

Responsibilities

- Learning and working inside of a patrol and troop environment.
- Teaching others.

Learning to Fail in a Healthy, Safe Environment

- Setting up tents in the right place, planning on cooking food the right way (do not burn the bacon).
- Cannot always "win"; learn how to accept failure and learn from it.

Leadership Development

- Multiple Leadership positions.
- Scouting offers multiple opportunities in leadership development within the troop and through scouting classes such as NYLT (National Youth Leadership Training) and Leave No Trace Program.

Cost Effective

• Baseline yearly cost is approx. \$200 (dues are approx. \$85-90, most campouts are \$30 per weekend).

Activities

- Monthly outings (camping, hiking, skill development).
- Summer camp is approx. \$250 to \$400 (location varies).
- COPE (Challenging Outdoor Personal Experience) and Climbing.
