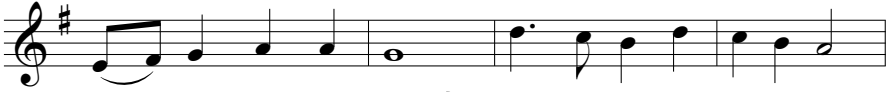

FIRST READING
